## About the Seal Awards...

### **What are the Seal Awards?**

JBQ Seal Awards are a great opportunity for quizzers to measure their level of JBQ knowledge through a series of one-on-one quizzes, increasing in difficulty as they go. Seals are open to all levels of quizzers and cover the entire five groups of questions. That's all 576 questions! The questions on the first four Seal quizzes (Discoverer, Searcher, Achiever, Master) are randomized each time, so the quizzer will answer a different set of questions each time they take the quiz. If a quizzer does not pass a seal quiz, don't give up - just try again the next week! You'll be surprised what you can do! You might even pass two seal quizzes in one sitting.

### **When is the testing?**

Testing will take place during JBQ from March 24 through April 28. Keep this handy sheet in your JBQ binder to track your progress. And if you have any questions, don't hesitate to ask us. We are here to help you!

### **Quizzer** \_\_\_\_\_

#### **Discoverer Seal**

10-point questions -- must get 20 correct out of 30.

#### **Searcher Seal**

10-point questions -- must get 25 correct out of 30, and  
20-point questions -- must get 15 correct out of 20.

#### **Achiever Seal**

10-point questions -- must get 28 correct out of 30, and  
20-point questions -- must get 18 correct out of 20, and  
30-point questions -- must get 6 correct out of 10.

#### **Master Seal**

Must get 59 correct out of 60 questions.

The breakdown is:

30 - 10-point questions

20 - 20-point questions, and

10 - 30-point questions.

#### **Master Quoter Seal**

Quizzer must correctly answer ALL Quotation Questions from the interrupt point in one sitting.

Must get 100%.

#### **Almost-Impossible Award**

Quizzer must correctly answer 575 out of all 576 questions in one sitting. Each question is read in its entirety and quizzer supplies the correct answer.

#### **Impossible Award (a.k.a. "The Doctorate")**

Quizzer must correctly answer ALL 576 questions from the interrupt point in one sitting, and may not miss any.
